

377 INTERSCHOLASTIC COMPETITION

The Board supports the concept of school district membership in appropriate conferences and/or associations, which will enable the schools to benefit from cooperative development and supervision of interscholastic competition.

The Board, in entering into any such membership, recognizes and agrees that any administrative or legal action contemplated by the Board in the name of the schools must conform to the published policies, rules, and regulations of the conferences and/or associations.

If conflict between the policies, rules and regulations of this school district and those of any conference and/or association in which this district maintains membership should arise, the Board reserves the right to decide in the best interest of the school district whether its policies, rules, and regulations should be placed in harmony with those of the conference and/or association, or the membership should be terminated.

The School District of Wisconsin Rapids does not discriminate in admission to athletic programs or activities, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of gender, race, color, religion, national origin, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, or physical, mental, emotional, or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
