## 448 STUDENTS OF LEGAL AGE

Every student eighteen years of age and older is an adult and shall have the rights, privileges, and responsibilities of adulthood. Such students, however, shall comply with all school rules, pursue the prescribed courses of study, and submit to the authority of teachers and others in authority over them.

A student of legal age may:

- 1. Exercise his/her right to control access to his/her student records in accordance with board policy and state and federal laws;
- 2. Sign absence excuses and permission slips himself/herself; and
- 3. Discontinue or forego school-parent notification procedures.
