## 470 STUDENT FEES AND FINES

The Board of Education shall provide a basic education program for students within the District. Certain activities, courses, and services may require additional funding not provided within the regular District budget. The Board may assess fees and charges in accordance with state and federal statutes. In the event that a high school course requires consumable materials as a part of its curriculum (i.e. workbooks or other necessary instructional materials), the student will be responsible for the full cost of those materials. The total amount of student fees; however, shall not be so prohibitive as to discourage participation in curricular and co-curricular programs. Parents/guardians whose financial condition prevents them from paying established fees may request financial relief in accordance with established procedures. Such requests shall be deemed as confidential.

Students or their parent(s)/guardian shall be responsible for payment of fines levied by the school for loss of or any damage, beyond normal wear and tear, to a book or other materials which are charged to him/her.

Band and orchestra instruments are available for rent in accordance with the approved agreement form.
