810 SCHOOL-COMMUNITY RELATIONS GOALS

The Board believes that the:

- 1. Public schools belong in every sense to the people who created them by consent and support them by taxation.
- 2. Schools are only as strong as and no stronger than the intelligent and informed support of the people of the community.
- 3. Support of the people must be based upon their knowledge of, their understanding about and their participation in the aims and efforts of the public schools.

In an effort to ensure and enhance the possibilities for excellence in the education of our children in a free society, the design and intent of the Board shall be to:

- 1. Keep the citizens of the district regularly informed through local channels of communication on policies, programs, problems and planning of the school system and to carry out this policy through the office of the superintendent.
- 2. Invite the advice and counsel of the people of the school district at all times and especially at all regular Board meetings.
- 3. Solicit the sound thinking and studied counsels of the people through advisory committees selected from the community and appointed by this Board to consider those problems which vitally affect the future of our children.
